

Scrappy Kennel Quilt



Finished Size = 12" x 18"

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Scrappy Kennel Quilt

Finished size= 12" by 18"

Materials Needed

- 13-14 feet of 2" wide fabric scraps in varying lengths
- 13" x 19" fabric scrap for quilt base
- 13" x 19" batting scrap for quilt base
- 12½" x 18½" backing fabric

Piecing Instructions

Please note: Use ¼" seams throughout construction, unless otherwise instructed.

1. Sew the 2" scraps together end to end to make a continuous strip of scrap fabric that is about 13 feet long. Cut into 12 sections, 13" each.
2. Layer the 13" x 19" fabric and the batting to create the quilt base, and then press or pin baste to hold the layers in place.
3. Place two strips from Step 1 right sides together along one narrow end of the quilt base from Step 2, aligning the edges. Sew along the top edge, and then flip the loose edge of the top strip toward the other end of the quilt base and press flat.
4. Place another strip face down on the unstitched edge of the top strip, stitch together and then flip the top strip toward the end of the quilt base. Press flat.
5. Repeat Step 4 with the remaining strips, until the quilt base is completely covered.
6. Trim the quilt base to exactly 12½" x 18½". Place right sides together with the backing fabric and pin the edges.
7. Stitch around the edges, leaving an opening to turn the quilt. Trim the corners to help them lie flat.
8. Turn the quilt through the opening, and then press the quilt to make it flat and smooth.
9. Quilt through all layers to secure the quilt top to the backing, using a stitch of your choice. Keep in mind that the quilting stitches should be small to prevent tiny teeth or claws from getting tangled in the quilt.

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
